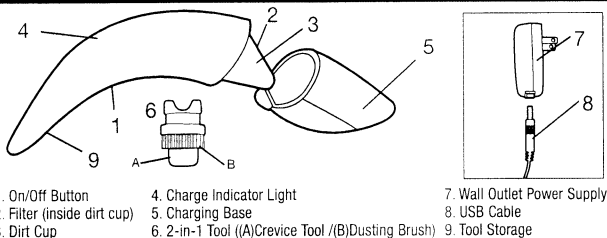
WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FIRE, ELECTRIC SHOCK OR INJURY:

- Do not use outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not charge the unit outdoors.
- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center for inspection. Call 1-800-321-1134 for the nearest service center or visit our website at www.dirtdevil.com.
- Do not abuse the cord. Never carry the charger or base by the cord or yank to disconnect from an outlet; instead grasp the charger and pull to disconnect. Keep cord away from heated surfaces. Do not pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not close door on the charger cord.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- This product includes rechargeable lithium ion batteries. Do not incinerate appliance and/or batteries, even if severely damaged, as they may explode.
- Do not store or use the appliance in locations where the temperature may reach or exceed 105°F (40°) (such as outside sheds or metal buildings in summer).

- Unplug the charger from the outlet before any routine cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not put any object into openings.
- Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use without filter in place.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids such as gasoline or use in areas where they may be present.
- Leaks from battery cells can occur under extreme or abusive conditions. If the liquid gets on the skin wash quickly with soap and water. If the liquid gets into the eyes, flush them immediately with clean water for a minimum of 10 minutes. Seek medical attention.
- Use only the charger supplied by the manufacturer to recharge.

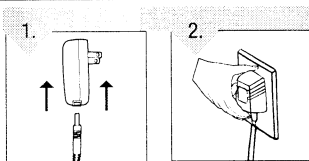
CHARGING USING WALL OUTLET POWER SUPPLY

NOTE: Only use power supply and charging base supplied by Royal Appliance Mfg. to recharge.

CHARGE 24 HOURS BEFORE FIRST USE.

1. Plug USB Cable into wall outlet power supply.
2. Connect wall outlet power supply into the outlet.
3. The charging indicator light will illuminate when cleaner is charging.

NOTE: The light will not turn off when fully charged.



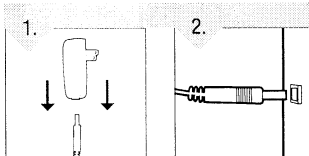
CHARGING FROM COMPUTER USB PORT

CHARGE 24 HOURS BEFORE FIRST USE.

1. Unplug USB Cable from wall charger.
2. Plug USB cable into computer USB port.
3. The charge indicator light will illuminate when cleaner is charging.

NOTE: Computer needs to be on to charge.

NOTE: The light will not turn off when fully charged.



HOW TO OPERATE

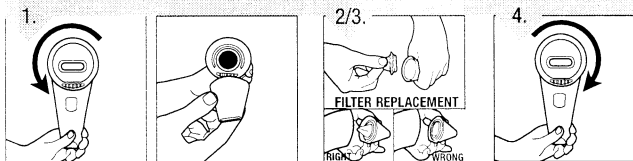
1. Remove cleaner from charging base.
2. Press power button to vacuum up dust and debris. Press power button again to turn vacuum off.

DIRT CUP & FILTER: REMOVAL & REPLACEMENT



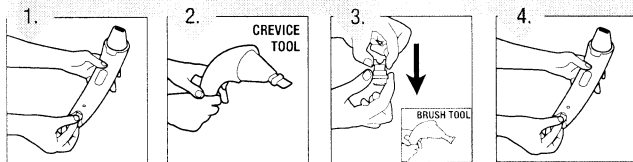
For F31 filter replacement, please visit our website at www.dirtdevil.com to buy online or call customer service at 1-800-321-1134.

1. Grasp dirt cup and remove by twisting dirt cup counter clockwise.
2. Pull filter out and empty contents into wastebasket. Remove any extra debris from the filter.
3. Replace filter. Firmly press the filter into the dirt cup and check the alignment of the filter. **NOTE:** Dust may escape through the exhaust if filter is misaligned.
4. Reattach dirt cup by twisting dirt cup clockwise.



2-IN-1 TOOL (Crevice Tool/Dusting Brush) USAGE

1. Remove 2-in-1 Tool brush from rear compartment of main unit.
2. Slide 2-in-1 Tool into vacuum nozzle.
3. To use 2-in-1 Tool as the brush, slide brush up until brush clicks in place. Slide into vacuum nozzle.
4. After use, return brush to original position for storage.



CHARGING CRADLE / INSTALLATION

NOTE: To maintain the unit always charged, always ready for use, it is acceptable/recommended to keep the unit docked to the charging base and the cord plugged into either the included power supply or your computers USB port.

The wall outlet power supply and charger base may become warm when charging.

BATTERY DISPOSAL
