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
#### **LIMITED WARRANTY**



## HOW TO ASSEMBLE & STORE


#### **ASSEMBLE HANDLE**



Place upper handle into body of cleaner and press down firmly. Handle will snap into place.


TO USE AS A

### **STORAGE/CORD WRAP**




To Store: hold unit in an upright position. Wrap/unwrap cord around hooks.

### HOW TO OPERATE




Turn unit on by using the on/off switch located on the body of the unit.


#### TO USE AS A Hand Vac



Push up on hand vac release lever.




Rock upper portion of the hand vac away from the unit. Lift the hand vac up and off of the base.

# **HOW TO OPERATE CONTINUED**




**TOOL USAGE** 

There is a nested crevice tool located on the back of the hand vac.


### RETURN THE Hand vac




To use, remove the crevice tool and firmly push the widest end of the tool into the nozzle of the hand vac.



The crevice tool can be used in tight places and corners.



Return the hand vac to the body of the stick vac by placing the nozzle on the base.




Rock the hand vac back until it locks into place.

### **DIRT REMOVAL AND CLEANING THE FILTER**

WARNING: TO REDUCE THE RISK OF INJURY FROM MOVING PARTS - UNPLUG BEFORE SERVICING.




While depressing the dirt cup latch, pull the dirt cup away from the upper body of the hand vac.



Remove the filter by pulling on the tab located on the outer rim of the filter. Pull the filter out of the dirt cup.



Shake the dirt cup and filter over a trash can. Do NOT wash filter with water.



Return filter to dirt cup.



When returning the dirt cup, line up the bottom of the dirt cup with the hand vac and rock the dirt cup up until the entire cup latches onto the hand vac.
